1. Procedures Performed:

Obtained from the Company its report on the application of the proceeds to the PSE, which contains an updated report on the use of proceeds from the Offering showing the following information:

- a) Unutilized proceeds as at January 1, 2015

- d) Amount of disbursement in Philippine peso
